Indicate if you'd like your submission to be considered for a department (specify) or a feature story, and be sure to include your complete contact information.

Manuscript Submission:

Send manuscripts via e-mail as a Microsoft Word attachment (.doc). Be sure to include contact information for all authors. Also include a brief author biography and a color photograph of the author/s. Photos should be at least 300 dpi for print publication purposes.

Copyright:

The *ABF Journal* accepts first North American Serial Rights. Authors must contact the editor for permission to reprint and source the *ABF Journal* in all subsequent printings.

References:

If references are required, please use the footnote function in Microsoft Word.

Artwork:

Submission of photographs, charts, tables and other graphics is encouraged. Images can be emailed as JPG, TIFF, PDF or EPS files. Images must be 300 dpi and a minimum of 4 inches by five inches. If the art has been previously published, permission from the copyright holder to reproduce or adapt the art must be included.

Author Responsibilities:

Authors are solely responsible for the content of articles submitted. The magazine accepts no responsibility for inaccuracies in manuscripts or references.
